Development Plans	Structure of EE SP has had discussions with three third sector support agencies: Accelerate – who cannot help us as we are already trading (WSSC), Just Enterprise who can help with trading, community engagement and fundraising issues, and the Development Trust Association Scotland (DTAS) who can help us with governance, HR, insurance/accountants' costs, fundraising and community engagement. SP expressed to all three our difficulties engaging with some parts of the island community and a very real fear that there will be no new directors nominated at the next AGM. DTAS explained that if EE has no directors it will have to be wound up: effectively all assets owned by EE would have to be sold, any creditors paid off and the events and premises managed by EE would no longer be under local control. The three current directors all agreed that without new directors added to the board they are all unwilling to stand again. It was agreed that there are great opportunities for funding for projects and support from Just Enterprise and DTAS, but EE needs more local enthusiasm to engage with them.
